

Exodus 14:13

I will not be afraid. I will stand firm (on God's Word) and I will see the deliverance (the breakthrough) the LORD will bring me today.

Deut. 31:6

I will be strong and courageous and bold. I will not be afraid or terrified because of (any opposition or potential problem), for the LORD my God goes with me; he will never leave me nor forsake me."

Deut. 31:8

The Lord himself goes before me and will be with me; he will never leave me nor forsake me. I will not be afraid; I will not be discouraged.

Psalms 23:4

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.

Psalms 27:1-2

The LORD is my light and my salvation-- whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life-- of whom shall I be afraid? When evil forces advance against me to devour my flesh (to oppress my mind, to depress my emotions), when my enemies and my foes attack me, they will stumble and fall. Though an army besiege me, my heart will not fear; though war break out against me, even then will I be confident

Psalms 46:1-3

God is my refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. Therefore I will not fear, though the earth give way and the mountains fall into the heart of the sea,

Psalms 56:3-4

When I am afraid, I will trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can mortal man do to me?

Psalms 62:5-9

5 Find rest, O my soul, in God alone;  
my hope comes from him.

6 He alone is my rock and my salvation;  
he is my fortress, I will not be shaken.

7 My salvation and my honor depend on God; he is my mighty rock, my refuge.

8 Trust in him at all times, O people;  
pour out your hearts to him, for God is our refuge. (*God is a safe place to be - Msg*)

Psalms 112:7-8

I do not fear bad news; I confidently trust the LORD to care for me. I am confident and fearless and can face my foes (challenges, obstacles, difficulties) triumphantly.

Proverbs 3:24-26

When I lie down, I will not be afraid; when I lie down, my sleep will be sweet. I will have no fear of sudden disaster or of the ruin that overtakes the wicked, for the LORD will be my confidence and will keep my foot from being snared.

Isaiah 12:2

Surely God is my salvation (deliverance, breakthrough, answer); I will trust and not be afraid. The LORD, the LORD, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation."

Isaiah 41:10

So I will not fear, for God is with me; I will not be discouraged, for He is my God. He will strengthen me and help me; He will uphold me with His righteous right hand.

Isaiah 41:13

For I am the LORD, your God, who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you. So I will not fear, because God will help me.

Isaiah 43:1-2

"I will not fear, for God has redeemed me; He has summoned me by name; I am His. When I pass through the waters (of adversity), God will be with me; and when I pass through the rivers (of oppression), they will not sweep over me. When I walk through the fire (of trial and difficulty), I will not be burned; the flames will not set me ablaze.

Phil. 4:6,7

I will not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, I will present my requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard my heart and my mind in Christ Jesus.

2 Tim. 1:7

For God did not give me a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline (& a sound mind)

Heb. 13:5,6
